Puppy preschool has been developed to help new and old puppy owners learn new skills to ensure their pup grows into a well adjusted valuable member of your family. We cover issues such as difficulty toilet training and helpful tips and hints for surviving the first few months with your new pup. Here is some important information to help get you thinking. What Is Puppy Preschool?

Puppy preschool is a four week course designed to help your pup to adjust to life in this world of ours.

We cover all aspect of puppy care including:

- Nutrition
- Parasite Control
- Basic commands
- Health and wellbeing
- Behavioural issues
- Socialisation

Our classes are based on a very social approach maximizing learning by making it lots of fun for you and your puppy.

Where is Puppy Preschool held?

We hold puppy preschool at our clinic in the main reception and also hold segments of the class in our main consulting room.

We do this to help the pup feel comfortable in our clinic and enjoy their time with us.

When is Puppy Preschool?

We hold puppy preschool on a Tuesday evening between 6-7 pm for 4 consecutive weeks. They are run as required.

The cost for the 4 week course is \$80.00

Who teaches Puppy Preschool?

Gina and Jess take the puppy preschool classes, both are nurses at the Orewa Vet Centre and have over 15 years experience between them.

They have been running the classes together since January 2005.

How many puppies are there?

Classes are limited to 6 pups but a minimum of 3 puppies is required before classes begin.

- Sit
- Stay
- Down
- Come
- Walk at heel

- Vaccinations
- Parasite control
- Pet insurance
- Nutrition
